

# Peugeot New Partner

- Active lane departure
  - Using a forward facing camera at the top of the windscreen to identify lane markings on the ground. System will correct trajectory of the vehicle if indicators are not used when crossing the lane marking. Operates from 40MPH.
- Speed limit recognition and Recommendation.
  - Indicates authorised speed limits in the instrument panel but is not 100% accurate. Does not control speed of vehicle
- Distance alert
  - Warns driver if risk of frontal collision. Does not prevent a collision!
- Electronic Handbrake
  - Releases automatically when driving off. Driver applies the handbrake by pulling the switch upwards. Handbrake applies automatically when engine switched off. Vehicle will sound an alarm should driver exit vehicle without applying the handbrake with engine still running.
- Hill Assist
  - System temporarily (approx 2 Seconds) prevents vehicle from rolling backwards when starting on a gradient. **Does not replace requirement for handbrake use.**
- Bluetooth
  - is a standard feature. Our policy prohibits any hand held devices being used including telephones with or without Bluetooth connectivity. Please refer to policy for guidance.

- Distance Alert
  - The Distance Alert function (collision risk warning) warns the driver that their vehicle risks colliding with the vehicle in ahead or a pedestrian present in his or her traffic lane. A visual and audible warning is made just before the Active Safety Brake is triggered.
- The Active Safety Brake Assist
  - If the Distance Alert is ignored, the emergency Braking system is activated to lower the impact. (Basically taking away that split second thinking time) It will not completely apply the brakes and does not replace the need for the driver to brake.
