Key Message

This SHE Flash is issued following a recent near miss that involved an employee not using the designated walk way, taking a short cut and walking behind a reversing vehicle.

Description

Operators / authorised personnel not using designated walk ways in operational yards.

Issue

Operators / authorised personnel choosing not to use designated walk ways, taking shorts cuts and walking in close proximity of moving vehicles.

Impact/effect

High risk of pedestrian contact with operational vehicles.

Learning Points

• All employees and yard users MUST adhere to yard rules and ensure that designated walkways are used at all times when walking in the yard.

Key Activity

- Unit PIC to review the content of their yard rules to ensure key points linked to the use of walkways are clear and will be clearly understood during yard rules deployment.
- Unit PIC to ensure yard rules have be cascaded / shared with all employees and are clearly displayed in key locations.
- Unit PIC to deploy targeted SMAT's (from a safe area) that are aligned to compliance to business standards / yard controls and adherence to yard rules.
